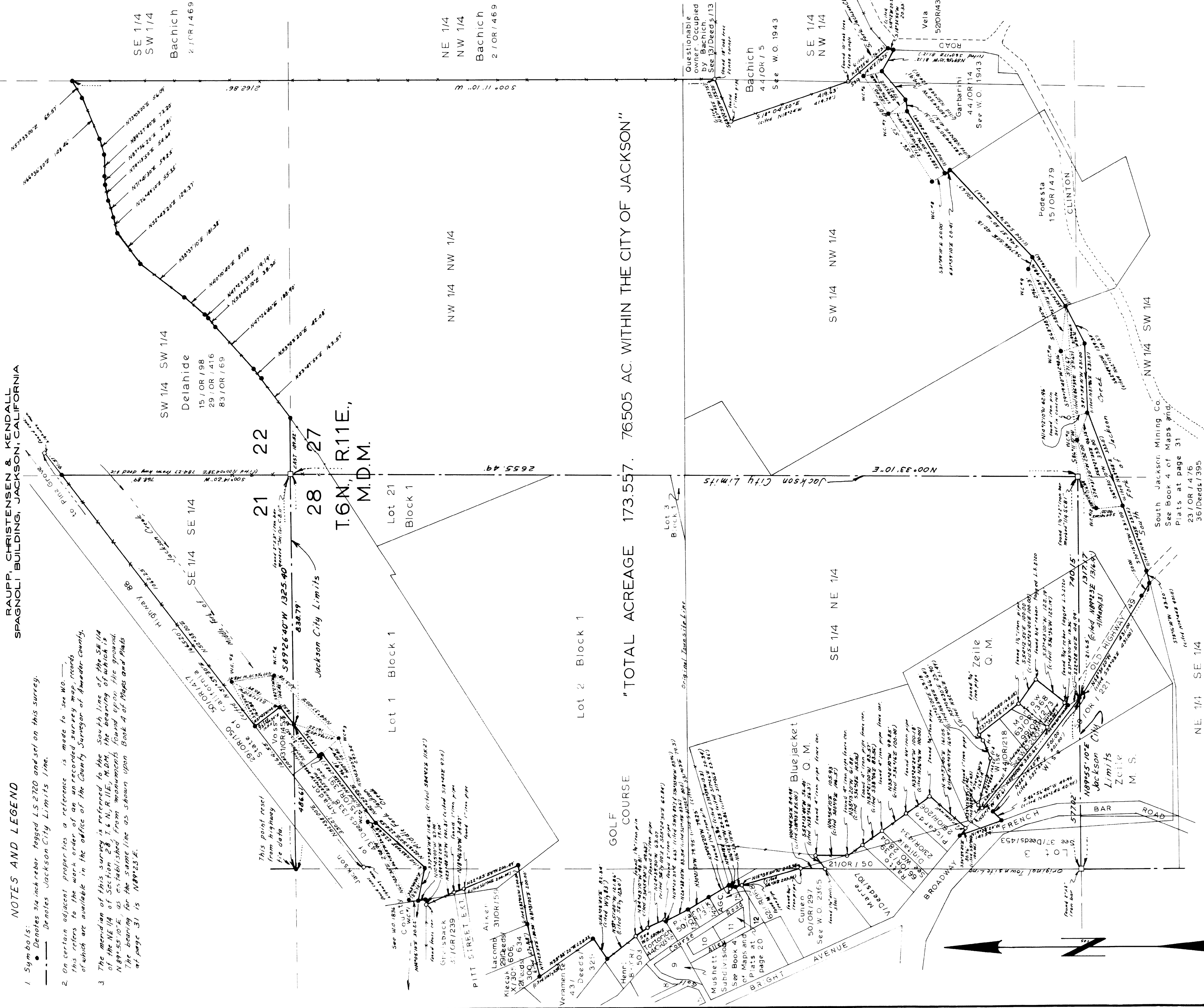


RECORD OF SURVEY

2. On certain adjacent properties a reference is made to "See W.O. \_\_\_\_". This refers to the work order of an unrecorded survey map, records of which are available in the office of the County Surveyor of Amador County.
3. The meridian of this survey is referred to the South line of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 28, T.6N., R.11E., M.D.M., the bearing of which is N. 89° 55' 10" E., as established from monuments found upon the ground. The bearing for the same line as shown upon Book 4 of Maps and Plats at page 31 is N. 89° 23' E.
